KHALSA COLLEGE EDUCATION IN EMERGENCIES POLICY.

- 1. The objective is to have minimum standards to ensure the safety of whole school community including students, teachers, children with special needs and school visitors.
- 2. EIE is concerned with education during and after emergency situations, rapid education responses during crises.
- 3. Common goal is to protect children and education workers from death and injuries in schools.
- 4. Three pillars of EIE include:
 - (i) Comprehensive school safety
 - (ii) School disaster management safe school facilities and
 - (iii) Risk reduction education.
- 5. Plan will be built on sound planning, preparedness, response and recovery.
- 6. Authorities shall select, design, construct and maintain safe school facilities.
- 7. Natural disasters as floods, fire, cyclones have impacted daily school operations.
- 8. Education needs to support national, parental and community needs providing support for all children in a manner responsive to their needs within a safe protective environment.

Procedures:

- 1. Planning safety of teachers, students, visitors, community
- 2. Prevention create safe, healthy school environment
- 3. Multi hazard risk assessment
- 4. Preparedness drills conducted, plans, procedures put, emergency plans reviewed, revised
 - Close school upon directives received from the Ministry of Education over the air or upon advice of NDMO.
- 5. Provide reports to District Office in events of disasters.
- 6. School will work in collaboration with staff and school management during disasters.
- 7. Emergency evacuation plan will be following formulated for school.
- 8. Conduct drill once a term in the school.
- 9. Develop school disaster management plan and emergency evacuation plan
- 10. Do awareness of emergency plans
- 11. Organise school clean ups to make schools safe for children
- 12. Provide guidance on safety to children
- 13. Be aware of common hazards
- 14. Follow directives of Permanent Secretary on closure of schools.
- 15. School will plan for physical/structural and academic recovery.

Tsunami/Flood

- Listen to warning from MoE/radio warning for the developments
- Upon confirmation of warning, the school will take immediate steps/actions
- Students will be released from the school for their safety/ parents will be informed for safety

- Immediate action will be evacuation procedure in the school.
 - Students/ teachers will stop all work immediately
 - Students/teachers will move out to the Assembly/ Compound area
 - Teachers will guide students to safety in upper playground area
 - Teachers/students will move and assemble in upper playground field of the school.
 - Teachers will be in respective lines with their form students
 - A roll call will be taken
 - Students will remain in the upper ground area till a clear signal is given by the administrators
 - Briefing will be done to the students to keep away from dangers/hazard prone areas
 - Once a clear signal is confirmed by the school head, then all the students will move in an orderly manner back to the classrooms.
- Normal lessons will then resume for students.

Cyclone

Warning taken heed of coming from the MoE/over air

Before.

- Classroom security checked
- Rooms to lock properly, secured
- Flying objects, material stored safely, trees trimmed
- Louvre blades, doors of rooms secured, repaired
- Students alerted on safety
- Keeping away from flooded rivers and streams
- Stay home, indoors once warning comes on air
- o Parents informed if school is closed, students taken home for safety

o **During**.

- All to stay indoors (safety)
- Keeping away from flood areas
- Evacuation centre set up if request comes from DO/SEO
- Evacuatees details sent to Education office
- Additional food, water stored
- Torch, battery kept for safety
- Reports sent every hourly to Education office.

After.

- Wait for Cyclone clear signal on air/ MoE announcements
- Keep away from damaged power lines or corrugated iron
- Assess damage, give a report to Education Office
- Clean up organised
- Arrangements made for clean water, power supply
- Assistance given to needy

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
