KHALSA COLLEGE POLICY IN SECONDARY SCHOOLS INSPECTION

- 1. Inspection done to provide assurance to stakeholders and to promote improvement and successful innovation.
- 2. Inspection shall target teaching and learning processes inside the classrooms.
- 3. Inspection shall be independent, vigorous, open and fair.
- 4. Focus will be on children's needs.
- 5. Analysis of questionnaires and face to face meetings will be held with a range of stakeholders.
- 6. All inspection activities shall be kept confidential from other bodies, agencies.
- 7. Inspection reports for each school shall be made available one month after the inspection is taken.
- 8. Internal follow up visits, reports shall be placed in Teachers Personal Files.
- 9. Inspectors may visit with or without notice and enter and inspect any school or any teacher.
- 10. School information shall be gathered from all teachers, all students.
- 11. After the visit, the staff who are non-performing shall be advised, counselled and warned by the inspectors on visit.
- 12. Inspectors concern shall be on:
 - (i) Leadership and management
 - (ii) Community and partnerships
 - (iii) Physical Environment
 - (iv) Students and Learning
